Recycling is a Crucial Part of Fighting Climate Change



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**Many of us within
East Dunbartonshire
are really confused
about Recycling**

There are two main Sources of Confusion

First Recycling information on Packaging
is generic to encompass the whole of the UK

Second Shops are by Law required to
provide recycling facilities within Store

**Unfortunately all Local Authorities have
different abilities and procedures
to cope with re-cycling**



**As a Community we are really lucky
in that East Dunbarton Council's
comprehensive recycling operations
cover almost all items which should
be recycled including many of those
offered by shops**

**There are two main issues at the moment
that EDC cannot accept in recycling**



The **First is Tetra Pak cardboard cartons for
Milk and Juice which need to be recycled at
ASDA Bishopbriggs recycling point**

The **Second is Rubber Gloves / Marigold Gloves
which need to be recycled at a
Terracycle Point Centre.**

There is no Centre near us at present

**Please also note the Polystyrene can only go in Grey Bin
if supplier will not take back**
