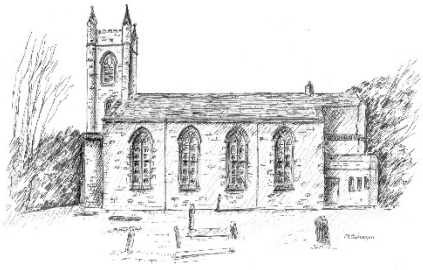

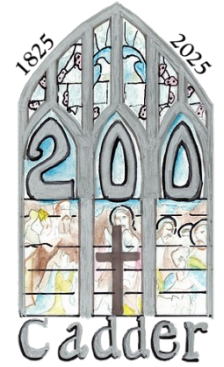
The service this morning is led by

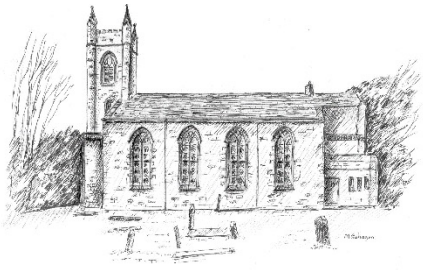
